Section History

Section 4A/4AA History

In 1995-96, high school wrestling in Minnesota went from 2 classes to 3 classes in both team and individual competition. The first season of the present 3-class system, the season of 1995-96, the 3 classes were named AA, A, and B, but one year later the 3 classes were renamed to: AAA, AA, and A.

The following is a brief history of Section 4AA team and individual results since the season of 1995-96.

In the 17 years since, section 4AA has been well represented at the state tournament. Section 4AA has won the AA team championship 11 times, including the last 9 consecutive years; the section has also been AA team runner-up three times, and one fourth place finish. On the individual side, 141 place-winners have come from section 4AA, including 33 state champions.

This year, we start the section 4AA individual section tournament with 16 returning state entrants, 5 of which placed in the state tournament last year including 4 returning state champions. The section tournament also touts 10 ranked wrestlers.

**Awards Presenter
Corporal Ethan Nagel**

Ethan is a graduate of Minneapolis Lutheran High School where he wrestled for four years and was a state entrant in 2005. After graduating, Ethan joined the Marine Corps where he served three tours of duty. This December, Ethan was awarded a Silver Star for bravery in actions against an opposing armed force in Afghanistan in July 2009. The Silver Star is the third highest decoration that can be awarded to a person serving in the United States Armed Forces.

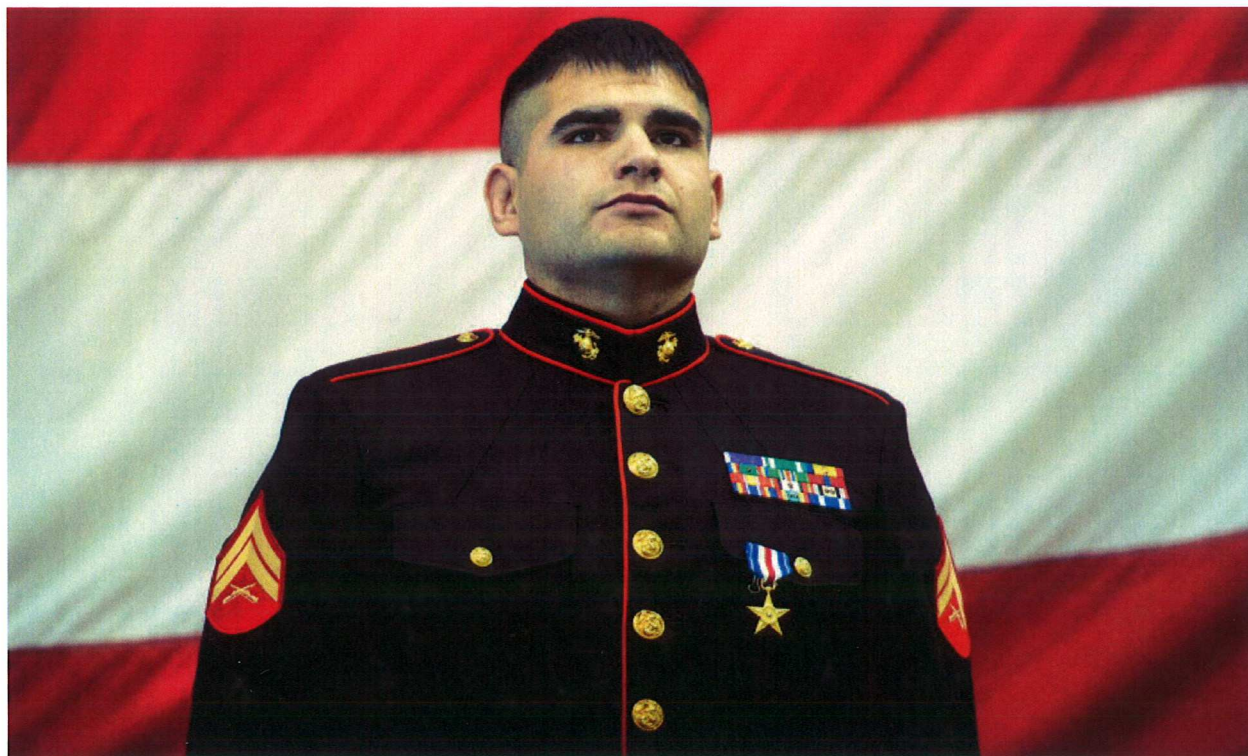

At the time, Ethan served as a military advisor to the Afghanistan National Army, while in the 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment. During a humanitarian mission, he, U.S. Special Forces and trained Afghani soldiers were ambushed by a superior enemy force.

During a prolonged firefight, Ethan was wounded by shrapnel and a Special Forces soldier was shot in the chest. Ethan gave up his position to initially provide aid to the wounded soldier and then defended him from Taliban fighters trying to capture him.

At one point in the fighting, Ethan was applying pressure to the wounded soldier's chest while simultaneously defending him with his pistol.

When the medical evacuation came, Ethan defended the helicopter during its descent and takeoff. The wounded soldier was airlifted out of the battlefield, but later died of his wounds.

For his heroism on the battlefield, Ethan was awarded the Silver Star.

Ethan was discharged from the Marine Corps in November 2009 and has since joined the Minnesota National Guard
